**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE USE OF COMPULSORY PROCESS REGARDING
SURVEILLANCE PRICING INVOLVING INTERMEDIARY COMPANIES**

Nature and Scope of Matter:

To compile information concerning surveillance pricing techniques by intermediary companies, pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 46(b).

The Federal Trade Commission hereby resolves and directs that any and all compulsory process available to it be used in connection with this inquiry. The Federal Trade Commission specifically authorizes the filing or continuation of actions to enforce any such compulsory process.

Authority to Conduct Investigation:

Sections 6, 9, 10, and 20 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 46, 49, 50, and 57b-1, as amended; FTC Procedures and Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 1.1 et seq., and supplements thereto.
