What are "junk fees"?

- Unfair or surprise fees or fees for unexpected or unwanted services that provide little to no benefit to the consumer
 - White House: "Junk fees" are "fees that are mandatory, but not transparently disclosed to consumers."


Common Additional Fees

- Concert & Event Ticket Fees (facility, service, convenience, order processing)
- Food Delivery Fees (delivery, service fees, mandatory tip)
- Bank Fees (overdraft; min balance; wires, max monthly deposit, NSF, ATM, in-person teller fees)
- Hotel Resort Fees (amenities, cleaning, valet, bags carry)
- Rental Application Fees
- Airline Fees (baggage; seat selection)





What regulators are focusing on at the federal level

- FTC:

- Proposed Trade Regulation Rule on Unfair or Deceptive Fees
- Negative Options ("Click-to-Cancel") Rule
- Combatting Auto Retail Scams (CARS) Rule (2023)
- Enforcement actions (*Amazon*, *Invitation Homes*)

— CFPB:


- Proposed rule prohibiting certain NSF fees
- Finalized Rule banning excessive credit late fees (lowering typical fee from \$32 to \$8)
- Enforcement actions (*BoA*)

– FCC:

- NPRM to eliminate video service junk fees from cable operators and direct broadcast satellite (DBS) providers
- Rule for all-in pricing for video service bills and marketing

Beginning July 1, 2024, the "Honest Pricing Law" or "Hidden Fees Statute," SB 478, which was recently amended by SB 1524, makes it illegal for most businesses to advertise or list a price for a good or service that does not include all required fees or charges other than certain government taxes and shipping costs. SB 478 is a price transparency bill. The statute does not change what price a business can charge or what may be included in that price. The law simply requires that the price listed include all mandatory charges.

Put simply, the price a Californian sees should be the price they pay.



SB 478 WOULD PROHIBIT

HIDDEN FEES IN CA



Mandatory Fees: Exclude Tax and Shipping



California

Mandatory Fees exclude taxes **or fees** imposed by a government and postage or carrier charges that will be reasonably and actually incurred to ship the good.



Minnesota

Mandatory fees exclude taxes imposed by a government. Reasonable postage or shipping fees that is actually incurred by a consumer may also be excluded from the advertised price.

Handling fees are not excluded and must be factored into the advertised price; Flat rate shipping?

What are reasonable shipping charges?



State-by-State Regulation Compliance

Breakfast Menu

<u>Fees</u>

20% Service Charge to cover cost of service, including rising healthcare insurance for staff and to offset other operating expenses.

1.5% Credit card processing fee to cover interchange fees

15% Gratuity will be added to your bill to recognize our staff for their service

\$0.10 Environment surcharge: donated to food recycling programs

Omelet \$8.00

Oatmeal \$5.00

Pancakes \$8.50

Coffee \$2.50

California SB 1524 created certain exemptions for restaurants, bars, grocery where mandatory fees do not need to be included in the price provided there is **Clear and Conspicuous** disclosure and an explanation of the fees purpose.

Minnesota HF3438- only the mandatory gratuity would be permitted to be disclosed outside of the price of item.

Other states such as NY and CT have restrictions on how credit card processing fees may be charged.

- 10 AG Elections in 2024
- New AGs: PA, NC, WA, OR, UT,WV
- 46/50 in alignment with Governor (NV, KY, PA, KS)



Disclosures and Pricing: 5 Things to Consider

- Variable Pricing adjusts prices based on demand, supply, competition, or other factors.
- Optional Fees whether optional fees are truly "optional" vs. "mandatory"
- Shipping & Handling shipping vs. handling fees
- Reference Pricing prohibited by many state laws where the first year price is described as a deeply discounted rate off of the second year price, but it is the same first year price that is always advertised
- Dark Patterns risks related to design choices and fee disclosure
- Subscriptions introductory offers and recurring charges



Price Transparency and Implementation Challenges

- These laws do not dictate prices or eliminate "junk" fees.
- Including all mandatory fees in the advertised price doesn't always square with the realities of the market or industry.
- California FAQ proposes that business that don't know how much they will charge a consumer at the beginning of a transaction *should wait to display a price* until they know how much they will charge.
 - Is this practical or helpful for consumers to not have a sense of a starting price prior to engagement?
- State-by-state regulation creates compliance challenges for nationwide providers to track and comply with disparate state provisions.
- Private right of action; Government Enforcement with civil penalties
