Here in my home country of Nigeria, a land with more than 250 ethnic groups and 500 languages, communication and respect for diversity is essential to our work as a Mercy Corps team. We ensure that 100,000+ people every month have enough food to eat, and we construct shelters for displaced persons affected by the conflict in northeast Nigeria. I've seen my fellow team members face threats from insurgency groups, and navigate insecure roads to reach distant communities, just to help people rebuild their homes, businesses and lives.

And the same kind of courage is happening in more than 40 countries where we serve. Our nearly 6,000 team members work side by side with people living through poverty, disaster, violent conflict and the acute impacts of climate change.
